The First at the State Level, Al Ain University Gets the International Certification in the College of Pharmacy

The College of Pharmacy at the Al Ain University of Science and Technology held the international certification from the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE), which is established in the United States, making it the first and only university at the level of the United Arab Emirates that received the international certification of pharmacy programs.

The college initiated the certification procedures in 2013, and permeated this period the field visits of the evaluation committees and reviews for precise objectives, learning outcomes, courses at hand and practical training at the college. In addition to interviews at the college, the teamwork of the administration and students has been crowned with success.

On this occasion, Dr Noor Aldeen Atareh, the AAU Chancellor, stated that this reliance was the culmination of efforts and hard work at the college and university level, and typifies the most important and unique accomplishment achieved by the university in order to improve the academic programs and a guarantee of quality pharmacy education. He even mentioned that the certification is due to the mainstay and complement efforts in the final appropriation stages of the college by the CAA in the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in the United Arab Emirates.
